Methodology

- Audience: Ukraine's population aged 18 and older in all regions, excluding the temporarily occupied territories of Crimea and Donbas, and territories lacking Ukrainian cellular coverage at the time of the survey. The results are weighted based on relevant data from the State Statistics Service of Ukraine
- $_{\odot}$ The sample is representative by age, gender and settlement type
- Sample size: 2000 respondents
- o Surveying method: CATI (Computer Assisted Telephone Interviewing). Based on randomized sample of phone numbers
- The error of representativeness of the study with a confidence level of 0.95: no greater than 2,2%
- $\,\circ\,$ Study timing: March 7-10, 2024
- The survey was conducted by the Rating Group under the commission of the Carnegie Endowment for International Peace.



Distrust of Russia is one of the main factors against negotiations. People who do not believe that Russia will fulfill the conditions, will refrain from attacking again after signing the agreement - are less supportive of negotiations. These categories make up the majority of the population.




Anticipation regarding international help as factor of confidence in victory


