







Trust toward institutions (%) (CB 2010)
















Statements regarding economic condition




Number of loans more than 100 USD (%) (Caucasus Barometer 2010)




**Close friends living abroad (%)


**Interest in emigration (%)




















During the last 5 years, quality of secondary education ... (%)
